The **OUTSTANDING EDUCATOR AWARD** is presented to an individual who has made significant contributions that enhance the education of children. An educator may be a teacher, specialist, support staff or administrator.

The **OUTSTANDING ADVOCATE AWARD** is given to honor an individual's dedicated service to ALL children and demonstrated commitment to helping create strong policies relating to the health, welfare, safety and education of children and youth.

The **GOLDEN ACORN AWARD** is given to people who have given exemplary volunteer service to children and youth in our school community, in recognition of their continued and dedicated service.

When we present a PTSA Award, we also contribute \$65 in that person's name to the Washington State PTA Financial Grant Program. This program provides grants each year totaling approximately \$66,000 to Washington state high school graduates entering their freshman year at a college, university or vocational school of their choice.
