- 1) Additional tickets may be available and will be allocated as follows: After June 1 e-mail Office Manager Peggy Brewer and state the number of additional tickets you would like. (brewerp@bsd405.org) Please be reasonable with the additional number of tickets you are requesting. Keep in mind that this should be a family occasion.
- 2) Tickets will be distributed to seniors on or after Wednesday, June 9th or when there is a reasonable assurance from weather forecasts that the ceremony will be in the stadium.
- 3) Additional tickets, as requested, will be distributed during the Senior Breakfast on the 15th of June.
Inclement weather (rain) forecast as of June 9th – each graduate will receive 4 tickets. Additional tickets will be available as the gym seating capacity dictates the number of available tickets.

- 4) Should the weather change for the good and the ceremony is in the stadium, additional tickets will be distributed during the Senior Breakfast.
